Mexican steakhouse and Google store to open in Miami, Warby Parker debuts in West Palm Beach (Photos)



A steakhouse from Mexico has landed in Coral Gables.

Rò Steakhouse opened Oct. 27 at the Alhambra Tower in Coral Gables.

The 7,000-square-foot restaurant, located at 121 Alhambra Plaza, Suite 110, marks the U.S. debut of ViCa Hospitality Group, founded by partners Carlos Aguirre and Victor Ferraez, who operate restaurants in Mérida, Mexico.

Designed by Arkham Projects and built by RAM Construction Management, the restaurant seats 130 guests and will later add an outdoor terrace.

“We hope to create a welcoming space where people can enjoy great food any day of the week, whether it’s a casual lunch, a family dinner, or a special celebration,” Ferraez said in a statement.

The menu, led by chef Marcelo Palacios, features wood- and flame-grilled meats, seafood and shared plates alongside an extensive wine and cocktail program.
