Designed with longtime collaborators Yakka Studios, the space balances country-club polish and stadium nostalgia with warm woods, rattan, brass details, custom sporting furnishings and curated memorabilia that create an inviting, indoor-outdoor room for up to 150 guests. Creative touches, from baseball glove lounge chairs to a clay tennis-inspired patio, root the concept in athletic tradition while nodding to South Florida style.
